Detailed Itinerary

Day 1: Gorakhpur to Pokhara (Nepal) via Lumbini (290kms/5hrs)

Arrive at Gorakhpur airport/railway station where our associate will greet you Proceed towards Pokhara via Lumbini (the birthplace of Lord Buddha) Visit Pokhara, situated beside the Phewa Lake. Check-in at the hotel after you arrive in Pokhara Dinner and overnight stay in Pokhara Pokhara (a metropolitan city of Nepal and the capital of Gandaki Pradesh) is often known as the Tourism Capital of Nepal as it's the gateway to the Annapurna Circuit.

Day 2: Pokhara to Jomsom (by Flight) to Muktinath

Have an authentic breakfast at your hotel and check out to get a transfer to Pokhara airport and catch a flight to Jomsom. Meet our associate at the airport and drive towards the blissful Shree Muktinath Temple (dedicated to lord Vishnu) on a Jeep on a sharing basis. Check-in at the hotel in Jomsom and take an overnight stay with dinner in Jomsom. Shree Muktinath Temple (dedicated to lord Vishnu) is located by the foothills of Thorong La mountain pass.

Day 3: Jomsom to Pokhara (by Flight) and Pokhara Sightseeing tour

Have an appetizing breakfast in the morning and get ready to be transferred to Jomsom airport. On reaching Jomsom airport, catch the flight to Pokhara. On arrival, start your day excursions with Bindabasini Temple, Seti River or Seti Gandaki River, Devi's Falls, Gupteshwor Mahadev cave, and Barahi Devi temple (boating at your expense in Fewa Lake). Enjoy your evening with a boat ride at an additional cost in Lake Fewa and experience the mesmerizing scenery of Mt. Fishtail and Annapurna range. Come back to your hotel and take an overnight stay in Pokhara.

Day 4: Pokhara to Kathmandu (210kms/3.7 hrs)

Have an authentic breakfast at the hotel and get ready for transfer to Kathmandu. En route to Kathmandu, seek blessings at Manokamana Devi temple (by Cable car for an Optional expense). On arrival post-evening, have a rejuvenating moment amid the markets and locale. Dinner and overnight stay in Kathmandu. Kathmandu is the capital city of Nepal situated amid the mountains of the great Himalayas. Filled with traditional amusement, it has a unique experience to serve. It's especially known for its impeccable architecture, wood carvings, sculptures, etc. The Hindu and Buddhist religions thrive together here.

Day 5: Kathmandu Sightseeing

Enjoy a filling breakfast in the morning and kickstart your day. Seek blessings at Pashupatinath temple (dedicated to Lord Shiva) on the banks of the Bagmati River. Explore the beauty of Boudhnath, the “Mini Tibet” in Nepal. Take a visit to Swoyambhunath stupa, known as the monkey temple, located on the hills of Kathmandu valley. Another sightseeing site is Patan Durbar Square (UNESCO World Heritage site) which connects with local people. Newari Street by the trimmed lanes and reach Krishna temple. Post this, Mahaboudhi stupa and Golden Temple are the marbles of tourism in Nepal. Take an overnight stay after dinner in Kathmandu.

Day 6: Kathmandu to Chitwan (162kms/3 hrs)

Have a delicious breakfast in the morning and check out from the hotel. Transfer to Chitwan, surrounded by beautiful nature sceneries. Check-in at the resort on arrival to Chitwan and settle yourself for a while. The evening starts with the traditional tour of Tharu villages where you can meet with some amazing indigenous people from Nepal. Enjoy the evening with Tharu stick dance. Form on your expenses. Come back to the resort, have dinner, and take an overnight stay in Chitwan. Chitwan houses one of the best-known and well-maintained national park sites of Asia—Chitwan National Park. You can watch several extinct animals here like horn rhinos, tigers, deer, and a wide range of nature’s creations.

Day 7: Chitwan Jungle Safari and Chitwan to Gorakhpur- Departure

Get ready for the Chitwan Jungle safari in the early morning on a jeep (at your expense). Watch one-horn rhinos, tigers, and other beautiful animals in the jungle safari. Come back to the resort and have lavish and authentic Nepali cuisine for your breakfast and take a few hours of rest. Pack up your bags to transfer to Gorakhpur. On arrival at Gorakhpur, catch your flight/train according to the scheduled departure.
